

2012-2013 TAX CREDIT INFORMATION

Note: Tax credits that were 30% up to \$1,500 EXPIRED on December 31, 2010. H.R.8 extended the original code section 25C credits at the 2006 levels.

This statement provides the documentation needed to receive a tax credit for Window Nation's windows and doors, as defined in the "American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012" (H.R.8).

How to qualify for the 2012-2013 Tax Credit:

- 1. To qualify for the energy tax credit, homeowners must purchase and install ENERGY STAR*-qualified windows, doors or other eligible products.*
- 2. Consumers can claim a credit of 10% up to \$200 of the purchase price on qualifying windows and/or 10% up to \$500 of the purchase price of qualifying doors for a total of \$500. The tax credit is for cost of the product only and does not include installation costs.
- 3. Tax credits under this law are capped at a cumulative lifetime total of \$500 for all qualifying products installed from January 1, 2006 December 31, 2013. See your tax advisor to check your eligibility.
- 4. Purchase and install qualifying products beginning January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013.
- 5. Save a copy of this document and your contract in order to claim the tax credit on your Federal filing for the 2012 or 2013 tax year.

RETAILER'S CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

Window Nation certifies that windows and doors sold and installed by the Company are eligible building envelope components and qualify for the Code Section 25C residential energy tax credit as extended by the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (H.R.8).
